The meeting to-day between Cardiff and Llanelly can be a classic if both play as well as they can do. Cardiff are due to show their top form to-day on the run of averages, and Llanelly have won their last three materials and the reel by displays of bright open rugby. Unfortunately for Llanelly, they lost their promising scrum-half Joseph Silva this week when he joined the Rugby League. At 24 he had shown form good enough to displace Handel Greville, the Club's

captain, and had played no small part in the Llanelly revival.




