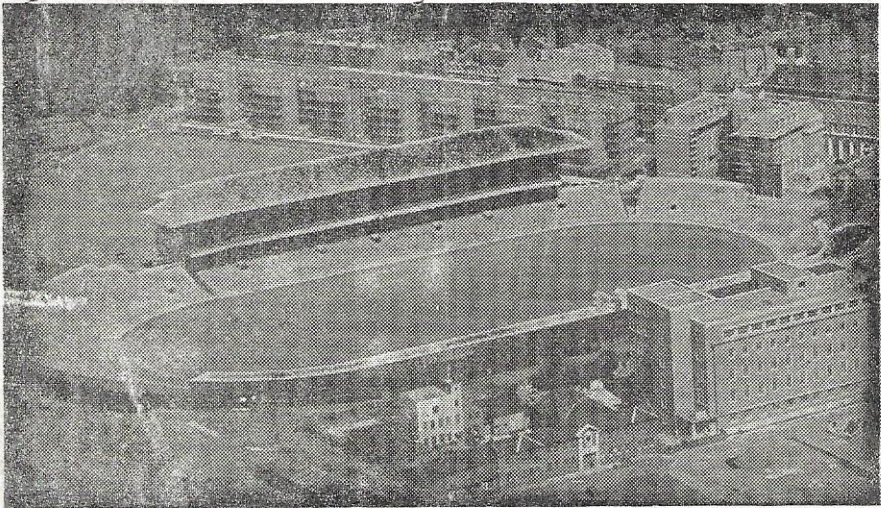

Cardiff v. Aberavon

We turn from the disappointment of last week's International in Scotland to Club Rugger once more and, in doing so, we welcome the "Wizards of the West" who, so far, have had a most successful season. Aberavon defeated Cardiff earlier this season by 11 points to nil and the Blue and Blacks will naturally be anxious to avenge the defeat today.

The Red and Blacks have put their strongest side in the field including as it does three who represented Wales at Murrayfield last Saturday. These are John Collins, Cliff Ashton and Haydn Davies who all play behind the scrum. They will be ably supported by Oxford Blue Tony O'Connor, Roy Bish and speed merchant Gwyn Davies. With a pack of 8 international standard forwards and a full-back who has made rapid strides this season, Cardiff have a tough task ahead of them, particularly as the boys from 'Bravon always appear to play better on the Arms Park than anywhere else.

Cardiff defeated the R. A. F. before a mere handful of supporters last week and will be anxious to do well today after the disappointing performances of recent weeks. Alan Friday who seems to be temporarily off form is replaced today by George Spear and Colin Hewitt returns to partner Richie Griffiths in the centre. Colin Howe, injured last week against the R. A. F., is replaced by Kingsley Jones who has loyally served the club in almost every position in the pack.

Next week the successful Cardiff Athletic side entertain Llanhilleth on the Park and Skipper Peter Nyhan at present on his honeymoon, will be back to lead the side.

The following week on February 28th there is a special attraction on the ground when the Welsh Schools play the South of Scotland Schools. Kick-off 3.15. Stand tickets at 5/- can be obtained from Mr. V. C. Phelps, 6 Bruton Place, Llandaff, Cardiff.

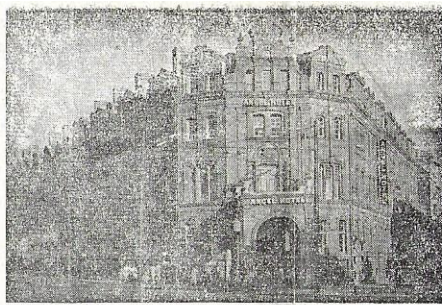

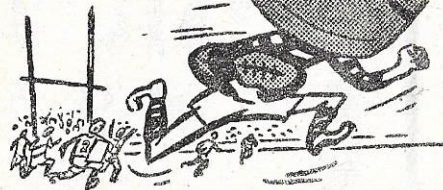
