### Welcome to the "Saints"

Cardiff faces the strongest challenge of its holiday programme today with the visit of Northampton, one of the strongest of English Clubs. They come to the Arms Park with five internationals and a British team player. The "caps" are Sykes, Butterfield, Berridge, Taylor and White, while Jeeps, the third scrum-half in the British team, has been an English reserve for two seasons.

Yesterday, Northampton lost by 24 pts. to three at Bristol, but as they were resting several of their leading players Cardiff can expect a big effort today!

In the past Northampton have always played well at Cardiff and, on paper, their side looks very strong today, Butterfield is one of the best centres in England and will renew his long struggle with Bleddyn Williams, who showed such good form against the Harlequins yesterday. His wing will be Sykes, who like Butterfield, has been chosen for the British Team to tour in South Affrica.

R. E. G. Jeeps is regarded as a very fine scrum-half and will have a tough partner in Brian Mark today. R. R. Winn at outside-half is the brother of Chris

Winn, while the other centre, R. Williams, appeared in Welsh trial.

The "Saint's" pack is a strong one, for Mike Berridge, the captain, has played many times in Wales and against Cardiff, and will lead the forwards. With him will be P. J. Taylor who played for England against Wales at Cardiff this season, and Don White, one of the best back-row forwards since the war. C. R. Jacobs played for the Barbarians against New Zealand last season.

Cardiff did not do well against the Barbarians on Saturday in losing by two tries to a penalty goal. As a game, it did not reach the standard of previous years, but yesterday against the Harlequins, Cardiff were much better. The game, too, was very lively, and interesting. Cardiff won by two tries to nil and well deserved the victory.

Outstanding for Cardiff were Alan Priday at full back; Bleddyn Williams in the centre and Malcolm Collins as pack leader. The play of Collins in the line-out was superb.

Several Cardiff players are on the injured list but today's side will play hard.




