PROGRAMME NOTES

It is with sincere pleasure and pride that we welcome the **CARDIFF** Club to the "Bandstand" Field to-day—their first official visit in the post-war period, and in the hope that this is the forerunner of regular fixtures. We pay a special welcome to Skipper—Dr. Jack Matthews, one of our own local boys, who has the distinction of leading his side for the third time. He takes the outside-half position in the absence of that grand little player—Cliff Morgan, whom we had looked forward to seeing in action to-day. We hope he will soon recover from his injury, and have many more Seasons in Rugby Football for his Club and Country. Another member of the Cardiff side who has served Bridgend in the past is that grand prop forward—Cliff Davies who has gained all the honours the game can offer. May we also pay a tribute to that fine Irish forward—Des. O'Brien, who has decided to retire after this Season. We are very pleased that he has an opportunity of playing in Bridgend before hanging up his boots.

Bridgend have remained unbeaten since the game at Cardiff Arms Park on the 1st December, and their record to date is :—
Played 32, Won 24, Drawn 4, Lost 4. Points : For—267, Against—96.

Bridgend did well to win at Cheltenham on Saturday despite atrocious weather conditions. This was Cheltenham's first defeat since December 29 last.
