

### Our Visitors . . .


The side Cardiff Rugby Football Club are fielding this afternoon is possibly the strongest they have produced this season. Strangely enough for Cardiff, it includes only three Internationals and one Trialist. Nevertheless, one of the three is that redoubtable British Lion, Cliff Morgan, the others being G. Rowlands and G. Wells. The Trialist is J. D. Nelson.

Unfortunately we shall not see Rex Willis in partnership with Cliff Morgan today. Willis has only just recovered from his broken ankle and he is trying it out against the Harlequin Wanderers this afternoon at Teddington. Incidentally, it is worthy of note that Cardiff Athletic are producing no less than five Internationals today.

On the Harlequin side M. L. Grant, I. D. S. Beer, J. J. Gardner and J. R. Simons are not available; the first is playing in the Scottish Trial and the last in the Welsh. J. J. Gardner is still crocked and is again replaced by J. Greenwood. K. North, who replaces Ian Beer, is a New Zealander now up at Oxford. This is his second game for the Quins' 1st XV.

Next week a very depleted Harlequin side is visiting Newport as six members of the club are required for the second English trial match at Norwich.






