**CLUB NOTES**

The experimental side with ten reserves in it which has done duty for the last two games deserves all praise for the defeat of Edinburgh Academicals. But a bright display from Mettler, who made a good try for Lee, converted by Rudd, and the craft of Sykes and Hughes brought us a good victory. In the pack, Hollingsworth and Bendon shone like beacons.

On Wednesday we were not so fortunate against Guy's. In the first half we attacked all the time and two good tries by Mettler and Lee were a just reward against a penalty goal by Guy's. After the interval this encouraging form disappeared and we took life so leisurely that we almost seemed to be playing in the middle of the nineteenth century. A good deal of scratching about in mid-field after Mettler had been injured did not help matters and we could not reply to a penalty goal and try by the Hospital. So a game which appeared to be well in the bag was lost.

Today several absentees return for the eager clash with ever-popular **CARDIFF**, led this season by the massive and genial Malcolm Collins. We welcome back Woodward, Simmonds, Evans (Mettler is first choice if fit), O'Brien, Yarranton and Cutter. Congratulations to Yarranton on skipping the London XV which beat Paris 15—3, and to Syrett and Cutter for doing so well, too. Concussion prevented Ted Woodward from also taking part in the match. He is now very fit again.

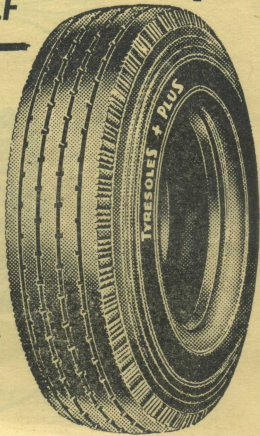
