

# CARDIFF v. NORTHAMPTON

Welcome today to one of the strongest sides in England who for many years have played Cardiff on Easter Tuesday. Long famed for their powerful pack, Northampton have in recent years also been very strong in the backs, so much so that their present side contains six English Internationals in the persons of R. E. Jeeps, scrum half, Geoff Butterfield and Lou Cannell in the centres and J. P. Hyde and F. Sykes on the wings and Heatherington at full-back. Of these only Butterfield and Hyde play today and in addition to these two caps the Saints have two other Internationals in the pack—Don White, the Captain and Phil Taylor.

This year's English full-back, Heatherington, is still in hospital suffering from concussion and we wish him a speedy recovery. Included in the Northampton side is a young hooker, A. C. Johnson, who last Saturday played for the English Schools against the Welsh Schools. He is obviously a great prospect for the future.

Both Cardiff and Northampton have had a strenuous holiday programme but we can always be assured of an interesting afternoon's rugby from the two sides.

The records show that in the games played in the past three years Cardiff have won two (by a margin of three points in each case) and Northampton one, again by a difference of three points which proves how evenly matched are the two sides.


