has an enviable record both as a Rugby player and sprinter. He learnt his football at Oldcastle Council School, which side he captained for two seasons. He figured in the Welsh Second

ary Schools XV for three seasons and captained the side in Season 1938-39. His first appearance in Senior Rugby was in the Welsh R. U. Final Trial at Swansea Season 1938-9, and the following season played for Wales against England at Gloucester, and also for Bob Oakes' International XV in North England. In games possible during the war, Dr. Matthews played for and captained the South Wales XV, and also for the Civil Detence of

NV. and also for the Civil Defence of Great Britain against Northern Ireland. While at the Cardiff Medical School he skippered the rugby side for four seasons, and during his meteoric rise to fame he has, besides playing for Bridgend, Cardiff and Glamorgan County (pre-way), figured in a number of representative matches.

Dr. Matthews is the son of Mr. George Matthews, now of Cardiff, a retired officer from the Surveyor's Dept., Glamorgan County Council.
