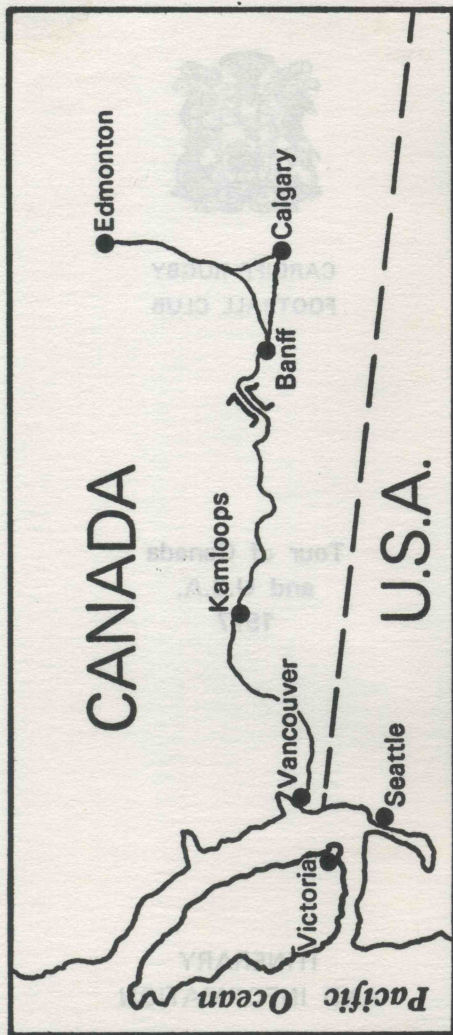

**VICTORIA** (Population 61,000) Capital of British Columbia. Overlooks Juan de Fuca Strait. Founded 1843 by Hudson Bay Company. Famous for commerce, distribution centre and tourism. Equable climate. Occupations lumbering, ship-building and food processing. Has a University and an Astrophysical observatory.

**VANCOUVER** (Population 42,000) At head of River Columbia. Founded by Hudson Bay Company. 1836 first steamboat entered Pacific (USS Beaver). Famous for manufacturing, farming, lumbering and commerce.

**SEATTLE** (Population 530,000) Named after Indian word "Seathl"—Indian chief. Chief city of Washington State. Port of entry to Orient and Alaska. Olympic Mountains and Cascades nearby. Railways arrived in 1893. Famous for manufacturing and industries. Boeing Company. 1962 World Fair held there. Space Needle. Fine parks.

**EDMONTON** (Population 495,000) On the North River Saskatchewan. Founded by Hudson Bay Company. 1891 Canadian Pacific Railway. 1890's Gold Rush. Famous for agriculture and processing centre. Recently oil. Large port. Has large University, Museum and Planetarium.



**BANFF** (*Population 3,530*) In S.W. Alberta on River Bow near Lake Louise. Named by Sir Donald Strathcona. Developed as a resort after arrival of Canadian Pacific Railway and establishment of National Park. Also on Trans-Canada Highway. School of Fine Arts, Museum and Sanitarium. Light manufacturers.

**KAMLOOPS** (*Population 25,000*) In S. British Columbia on N. and S. Thompson Rivers. Founded by Alexander Ross (trading). Named after "Cumploups"—Indian for meeting of the waters. Hudson Bay Company took over in 1821. Gold in 1850's. Railroad in 1885. Famous for ranching, lumbering and food canning. A railway centre and junction of 3 main highways.
