

Know the Laws


Christmas over once again. Did you have a go at the questions in the Boxing Day programme? They shouldn't have been too difficult to regular followers. I shall be in the clubhouse early, hoping to give that pint to the first "all correct". Here then, are the answers.

- The two members of the W.R.U. who represent us on the international board are Ken Harris and Hermas Evans.
- 2. The officer of the Union, directly responsible for the training of our referees, is the coaching organiser, Ray Williams.
- The two methods whereby the initial steps for referees' grades are made are the card system (a card is marked and sent in after every match), and by observation by a team of assessors. This applies to ALL matches and ALL referees.
- The change in the field markings introduced this year meant that the 15 yd.
 in from touch marks intersecting the goal lines extend 5 yds. into the field
 of play.
- 5. The important change regarding replacements extended this law so that it could apply to 'such competition and other domestic matches as a Union gives express permission', in adddition to 'matches in which a national representative team is playing'. The same conditions only two players, doctor etc., still appertain.
- 6. The new clause introduced, relating to the spacings between the players in the line-out means that the two feet between the lines must be kept until the ball touches the ground, or has been touched by a player except when jumping for the ball or peeling off.
- 'Advantage' can be taken if the ball is put into the scrum unfairly and the other side get possession. The referee must decide.
- 8. The conditions necessary for a 'Mark' to be allowed are: 'he must be stationary, must catch the ball cleanly from a kick, knock-on, or throw forward, must have both feet on the ground and must exclaim 'Mark'.
- When players change clubs, the CLUB applies for a permit (maximum 6), the player himself has to apply for his transfer.
- 10. If the referee is injured during an international match, the home Union touch judge will take over. This is the reason why the touch judges for internationals have to be referees of international standard.




