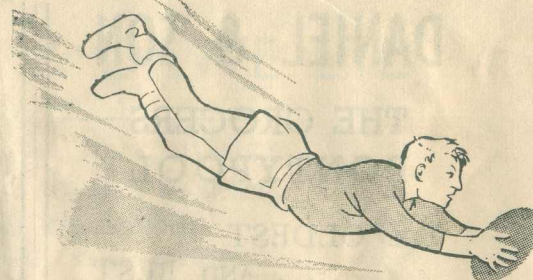

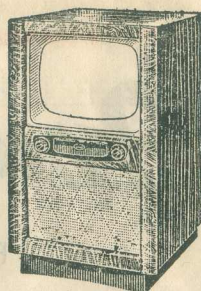

Supporters' Club Corner

LAW 35. Repeated infringement of the Laws.

- (a) Where a player infringes for a second time any of the provisions of Law 34—Foul Play—the referee **must** order the player off the playing enclosure.
- (b) Where a player repeatedly infringes any of the provisions of Law 20—Charging and Obstruction—the referee **must** order him off the playing enclosure.
- (c) Where a player repeatedly infringes any of the Laws other than Laws 20 and 34 the Referee **must** caution him and must, in the event of any further repetition of the infringement in respect of which the caution was given, send a report naming the player and the circumstances to the Union having jurisdiction over the match.
