## CARDIFF AND DISTRICT RUGBY UNION

In conjunction with the City of Cardiff Festival of Britain Committee, the Cardiff and District Rugby Union has organised a Seven-a-side Tournament, to be held at Blackweir on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, the 3rd, 4th and 5th May, 1951.

Thirty teams have entered for this Tournament, and the final will be played on Saturday, 5th May. The Committee is arranging for the final to be played by 4.30 p.m. on this afternoon, in order that the Lord Mayor of Cardiff (Alderman George Williams, C.B.E., J.P.) can present souvenirs to both teams in the final.

It is absolutely essential that teams must be ready to take the field at least five minutes before the scheduled time, otherwise the organising arrangements cannot be completed. The first round will be played on Thursday, 3rd May, 1951, commencing at 5.30 p.m., and the second round will be played on Friday, 4th May, 1951; commencing at 5.30 p.m. The third round semi-final and final will be played on the afternoon of Saturday, 5th May, 1951. Full details of the time of play will be issued to each team taking part.

### RULES.

1. Each game shall be played six minutes each way (except the final tie, which shall be played ten minutes each way), and if at the end of such play neither side shall have won, ends shall be changed and shall continue to be changed at the end of six minutes or ten minutes, as the case may be, until one side scores, such side being the winners, and no further time being played. The interval at half-time shall not exceed one minute, and in the event of extra time being played there will be no further intervals.

2. A scrummage shall be formed by not less than three players on each side.

3. With the exception of the final tie, teams must be prepared to turn out immediately on completion of the tie previous to that in which they are engaged. In the event of any team refusing to so turn out they will be automatically disqualified and their opponents will be declared the winners.

4. Each team taking part will be allowed to choose their team for each round from eight nominated players. In the event of an injury, the eighth player must be brought into the team for the next round. In the event of a second injury of a serious nature, the Committee may at their discretion allow a further reserve. Substitutes are, of course, not allowed during the course of a game.

5. Only players and officials are allowed to enter the field of play.

6. Half an hour's interval will be allowed between the second, semi-final and the final tie.
