GLAMORGAN WANDERERS v CARDIFF

ON SATURDAY, 19th DECEMBER, 1981

KICK OFF 3.00 p.m.

This afternoon we welcome our near neighbours, Cardiff, for their second visit to the Memorial Ground this season. Today Cardiff visit the Wanderers in their capacity as the current Schweppes Cup holders out to defend their title.

When Cardiff played at the Memorial Ground in September they were without this season's captain, John Scott, who was injured and although he is slowly regaining his fitness after surgery it will still be some time before he can lead his side. However, Cardiff are in the healthy position of having Gareth Davies, the current Welsh skipper as their Vice-Captain to take over John Scott's duties.

The Cardiff side includes five internationals—four of whom played a fortnight ago in the Welsh win over the Wallabies. The Wanderers are delighted that one in particular is here today. Pat Daniels returns to the Memorial Ground for the first time in four years since leaving the Wanderers to join Cardiff in 1977. At that time the Wanderers were sure he would soon get his cap, however, during the past four years he has been dogged with injury problems and all at the Memorial Ground were thrilled with both his selection and performance against Australia, where incidentally, Pat toured with the Welsh party in 1978.

When Cardiff came to the Memorial Ground in September the Wanderers made them work hard for their 9 points to 3 win—the winning score coming in injury time. Since then Cardiff have been playing excellent rugby and have only been beaten twice in 22 outings by Aberavon and Pontypool with two drawn matches against Coventry and last Saturday a 17 minute game with London Welsh. Indeed the side which played last Saturday does duty today.

The Wanderers, unlike Cardiff, had a blank day last Saturday as the weather took its toll on all sports. Today's side shows one change from the game at Pontypool where Chris Bennett returns to the wing forward berth to allow John Griffiths, who again captains the side in the absence of Phil Adamson, to revert to the No. 8 spot. Although losing to Pontypool by 23 points to 10 the Wanderers continued the habit of scoring outstanding tries against "Pooler" — the third in successive games. This time the try started in the Wanderers 22 working its way up the left hand touchline before passing across the entire back division to the right hand corner for Matthew Stork to score a copy book try. Indeed the back division looked very sharp and caused no end of trouble to the Pontypool defence. It needed some accurate goal kicking by "Poolers" full back to keep them in front.

During the last seven games the Wanderers form has improved and with the added atmosphere which cup rugby generates John Griffiths and his team will be working overtime for eighty minutes today to try and emulate the cup performance against Swansea—here at the Memorial ground a few years ago—when they provided the upset of the season.

The Athletic fifteen have been turning in some fine performances of late and are currently well placed in the Glamorgan County Silver Ball table, having won all their games. Supporters will have an opportunity to judge for themselves on Monday night when Tondy are the visitors, kick off 7.15 p.m.

The Senior teams next match is on Boxing Day when Swansea are the Wanderers opponents at St. Helens. The next home fixture is on Monday, 28th December, kick off 3.00 p.m. when Lydney are the visitors. The weather has already taken its toll of cancelled matches and supporters should make a note of the following additional fixtures in January 1982. On the 6th Abertillery are met away whilst on the 9th and 13th Cheltenham and Aberavon come to the Memorial Ground.

Finally, may we extend to everyone the compliments of the season and hope to see you all again in the New Year.
