

Dear Fellow Rugby Nutters,

Long ago in the second month of Bristol Football Club's existence they took on Cardiff on the 6th October 1888. 48 matches later they had won three times 3 - 0, 3 - 0 and 9 - 3, very slender margins indeed. In the next 40 matches they did a lot better winning 16 times and drawing 4, almost equalling Cardiff's points tally. However, post war experience has resulted in 59 defeats in 74 games.

Why then does Old Cabot reckon Bristol are due for a win tonight? Well look at the evidence, slender though it may be. Bristol won 28 - 8 in September 1980 then lost the next three. In September 1982 Bristol won 22 - 9 and then lost the next three. Here we are now in September 1984 ready to repeat the sequence. Clutching at straws? Any club playing Cardiff seems to have precious little else to clutch at - but remember this. Determination, not odds, wins games and let's wish Bristol success on that score.

9th February 1973 Bristol 9 Cardiff 10

When Bristol ran on to the field that night they had won only twice in the past ten years. Moreover, an injury crisis had left Bristol not only without a fly half but had deprived the club of their captain. Jon Gabitass then teaching at Clifton College came in at outside half for the injured Tony Nicholls and John White took over the captaincy.

After 13 minutes from the kick off Cardiff were 7 points up and the familiar old picture seemed to be emerging. However, Bristol showed the guts and will to fight back that can transform underdogs to potential winners. By half time they were leading 9 -7 and the crowd, excited by Bristol's great back row (Rollitt, Speed & Hannaford) fairly buzzed at the possibility of a win. Coming back from the blow of a Cardiff try after only 30 seconds from the kick off Bristol had every right to feel proud of leading at the interval.

Unfortunately, dreams are easier than real life. Heroically though Bristol defended - and what is more took the attack at times to Cardiff - the inherent superiority of the opponents took its toll. It needed desperate defence to retain their lead but in the 55th minute Cardiff kicked a second penalty to lead by one point. That was, however, the only score in the second half. For the next 25 minutes Bristol held on.

In the end to lose by one point might be seen as disappointing. But rugby is about striving like hell to acquit yourselves as well as you can and not necessarily about winning. That night Bristol did percisely that - and tonight can we really ask for more?




