World of Referees

One burning question, which cropped up time and again following the Welsh win over England was, should the referee have allowed the Dewi Morris "trv".

perfectly David Herbert positioned in the South Stand to see the whole and, thing, not withstanding a clear knockon which the referee missed, I was in no doubt that a try should have been awarded.

Let me qualify this by quoting from law. It states that "If a tackle occurs in such a position that the tackled player whilst complying with the law is able to place the ball on or over the line, the try should be awarded".


Dewi Morris met all the criteria laid down in this law, and in my opinion. was unlucky not to have been awarded a try.

To describe the line-out as a lottery in the International matches I've seen during this championship, would be an understatement. It seems to me that, providing the ball comes out, anything goes. That this hasn't lead to more hostile confrontation is a credit to the discipline of the players involved at these phases.

The comment has been made that our players are not "street-wise" and should adopt the same tactics as their opponents. I honestly feel, that in Wales, our referees genuinely try to control this area of the game. If they didn't, they know that pretty soon they'd have open warfare on their hands.

Referees at all levels have a responsibility to referee the game within the laws. One former International referee has been heard to say that in ordinary matches you referee the "Laws" but at International level. vou referee the "Rules".

This more than suggests to me that at the highest level of the game, referees think that they have a license to opt-out of applying the laws correctly. This theory has been confirmed by recent events at International level. Perhaps they believe that the International factor far outweighs their obligations to the most important people in the game, the players. If so, they are wrong.
