Know the Laws

The questions were there on Saturday. Here are the answers. How did you find them? Not too difficult I feel.

1. A push over try is permissible because a scrummage can only take place in the field of play. In-goal, that scrummage ceases to exist. The ball can then be handled.
2. Ball knocked on in-goal by an attacking player. The correct decision should be a drop out 25.
3. There is only one decision if the referee is in doubt as to whether an attacking player or a defending player first grounds the ball in-goal. It must be a scrum 5 with the attacking side putting in.
4. In a line-out the players there-in can only move within the obligatory distances they have to remain apart when the ball leaves the hands of the player throwing it in.
5. Those obligatory distances are, one yard from the next player of his own team in front of him and a clear space of two feet between the two rows of players.
6. The penalty for any line-out 'offside' offences must be 15 yards from touch, along the line of touch, if the player involved is participating in the line-out. If by a player not involved in the line-out, the kick would be on the offending team's off-side line, opposite the place of infringement but not less than 15 yards from the touch line.
7. If the ball, or player carrying the ball touches the referee, in the field of play, play should continue unless that act has given an advantage. If so, then it would be a scrum to the team which last played the ball. If, in-goal, a player carrying the ball touches the referee before grounding the ball, a try would be awarded at that place.
8. If a player is fouled after he has scored a try, the conversion would take place and then a penalty kick from the half way spot where the ball would have been next brought into play.
9. The conditions necessary for a fair 'Mark' are: a player cleanly catches the ball direct from a kick, knock on or throw forward, at the same time calls 'Mark', is stationary and has both feet on the ground. A 'Mark' can take place in-goal or after it has rebounded from the goal post or cross bar.
10. The two Welsh representatives on the International Board are Ken Harris and Hermas Evans.
