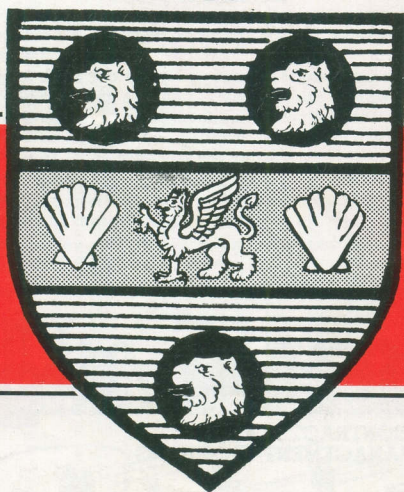

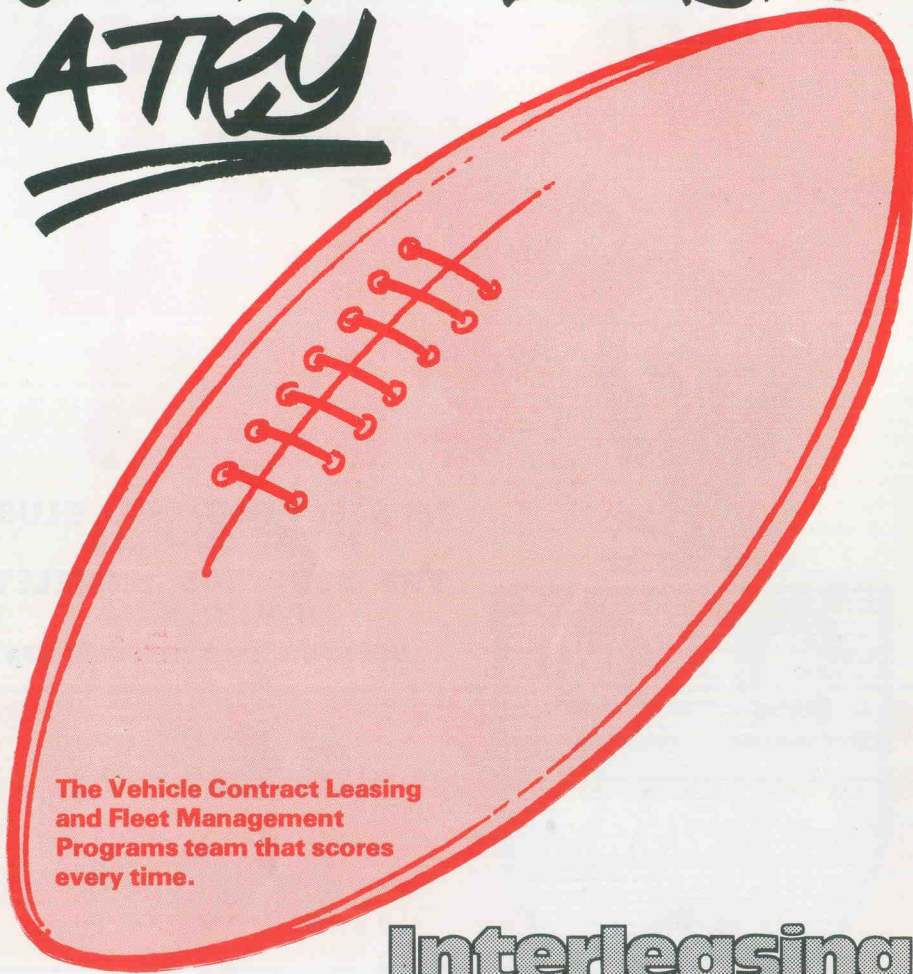

MOSELEY NEWS

• MOSELEY v CARDIFF

Always popular visitors to The Reddings and anywhere else for that matter, we welcome the Cardiff club which is and always has been a great one.

Last season they won the *Schweppes* Welsh Rugby Union Challenge Cup for the second successive season by beating Bridgend.

By a strange co-incidence the score being 12 points each, but Cardiff won the trophy because they had scored a try.

This afternoon's match should be of particular interest in view of the fact that it is a meeting between the two Cup winners.

We have had a regular fixture with Cardiff since season 1973-74, and of the last 12 matches played Moseley have won four and Cardiff five.

Last season at The Reddings we lost narrowly by 24 points to 26, having at one stage in the match been 9-26 in arrears, and in the end we were unlucky not to finish up winners.

On our opponents ground on New Years Saturday we lost by 14 points to 25.

Some 170 Cardiff players have represented Wales and some 35 have been British Lions. Perhaps most people would agree that the two greatest were Gareth Edwards with 53 caps, and Gerald Davies with 46 caps.

During season 1965-66, our visitors were our guests at the opening of our floodlights.

Although they have lost several matches this season, it is worthy of note that on Saturday last they gave the touring 'Maoris' an extremely close game, losing by 10 points to 17.

Skipper John Scott has won over 20 England caps and looks good enough for many more. Gareth Davies and Terry Holmes have been the regular Welsh half-backs for the past five seasons. Apart from these players there are a number of really top-class performers.

At the time of going to press, owing to a mid-week fixture, the Cardiff side had not been selected, but there is little doubt that it will be a strong one.

The Moseley side shows several changes from that which lost to Coventry.

Several excellent displays for the United have earned young Simon Hunter a place on the wing in place of Clive Meanwell. Simon is a forceful runner with a large physique. At the moment he is a student at Warwick University. He was recommended to the Club by Keith Hatter now with the Torquay club.

In two appearances for the United he has scored several tries, and he is a particularly strong runner. We wish him the very best of luck.

The other change is Kevin Astley in place of Martin Head in the front row, the latter being unfit, and Dave Shorrocks returns after County duty last Saturday, he replaces Alan Thomas.

We can look forward to an interesting and we hope a close contest.
