There is, and always has been, something special about a home game with Cardiff. The Club's first official fixture was against the famous 'blue and blacks' in 1888 and they were our first fixture in our recent Centenary season. Interspersed between these two dates were two other celebratory fixtures: the opening of the Memorial Ground in 1921 and the silver jubilee match in 1946. There have, of course, been the regular inter club fixtures which have been played on an home and away basis. These Club games have usually provided some marvellous Rugby for both Clubs have a tradition of fifteen man Rugby. It is interesting to read that Gareth Edwards, Cardiff's record cap holder with fifty three appearances for Wales, and Terry Holmes, two of Cardiff's finest half backs, have both publicly written that they both have the happiest of memories of playing in this fixture.

There is a sad note to tonight's match. For over fifty years, firstly as a player and then as an official, Stan Bowes has been a member of the Cardiff Club. Sadly Stan died earlier this season. Those of us on this side of the Bristol Channel always relished his company. He was able to galvanize the most solemn occasion with some thought or wit that would soon have the smiles appearing. He rejoiced in telling of escapades in Harvey's cellars following a Rex Willis game; of the warmth of New Zealanders when they found out that Stan had played for a team that had beaten the All Blacks; but above all stories of his Club's games and players gave him enormous pleasure. He frequently confessed to having a great affection for the Bristol Club. It's no secret that the feeling was reciprocated many times over to a fine man.

Club Notes

Following the disappointment at Cardiff last Saturday we welcome our old friends from the Cardiff Club. Whilst Rugby is a team game there is little doubt that the most significant contribution to Wales' victory was the superb line out display given by Robert Norster of Cardiff. We were, of course, disappointed by the result, but readily admit that once having secured the lead the Welsh forwards, supported by an astute scrum half, provided some 'quality ball' to ensure prolonged Welsh pressure. It is intriguing to ponder if last Saturday's match will significantly change the composition of the British Lions tour party which is due to be announced on Wednesday.

Cardiff, after an unusual slow start to the season, have recently showed improved form. They crushed London Welsh last Friday evening. They are also a fine cup side and they have taken their place in the semi-finals of the Schweppes Cup. Tonight's rearranged game was caused by Cardiff's involvement in the quarter final tie of the Cup. It is pleasant to record that, inspite of a heavy club fixture list, a semi-final cup tie, they have honoured the re-arranged fixture.

Last weekend's fixture at Leicester in the Courage Clubs League was again one of those close encounters which slipped away from our grasp. When one recalls the events at Rosslyn Park, Bath and Leicester one wonders when Dame Fortune will show her other side. However, six of our players, Andy Dun, Wayne Hone, Andy Blackmore, John Carr, Ralph Knibbs and Tim Edbrooke plus coach Bob Hesford supported members of the Gloucestershire Rugby Union's Coaching Committee in a two hour coaching session for 50 Bristol Schoolboys aged 14 and 15 held at the Memorial Ground on Sunday Morning. The Schoolboys thoroughly enjoyed the session and hope to show their newly acquired expertise at the Festival of Youth Rugby which is being staged at the Memorial Ground on Saturday, 1st April. The Festival starts at 10.30 a.m. and ends at 5.30 p.m. There are Mini Rugby Competitions spliced in with representative matches at Under 12, Under 14, Under 15, Under 18 and a Colts game. This promises to be a good day's Rugby and is commended to you.

Another fixture we recommend most strongly to you is the 18 Group international between England and France which is being staged at the Memorial Ground on Easter Tuesday, March 28th Kick-off 3.00 p.m. The French Schools are a formidable combination and seldom lose at Schools and Youth level. It was at this age group that Serge Blanco first attracted attention of the French National selectors. The England Schools team has grown in stature in recent years and achieved a remarkable series of victories last Summer in the Southern hemisphere defeating both Australia and New Zealand.

Members and supporters are reminded that next Saturday's opponents will be New Brighton and on Easter Monday we entertain Glamorgan Wanderers.






