

#### **CLUB SCENE**

#### ONE MAN'S RUGBY - HAROLD'S EIGHTY! BY ROD REES

"The first match I played in was in 1928", said Harold Powell. "I played for the Boys Brigade against the Boy Scouts. I was picked in the second row and I didn't like it very much. So I picked up the ball, ran the length of the field

and scored a try. I was immediately transferred to the backs!"

And that's where Harold who celebrated his eightieth birthday this week stayed, playing during three decades, the thirties, forties and fifties. He moved up to the man's game with Neath "Shoppos" who played on Thursday afternoons, the

traditional early closing day for the retail trade.

Then, at the age of 18 was given a trial by Neath and began deputising for the fine Neath Wings Dan Jones and Hickman. Harold was finding it difficult getting a job in the Neath area. Guess who offered the promising young player a job? Right first time, Swansea! Some things never change.

He came back to Neath for a while but spent

most of those pre-war years playing for the Whites. To this day Harold Powell, a Neath man, holds a proud Swansea record. In 1935 he became that club's record try scorer with 35 in the season including 6 in one match and a run of three matches where 11 tries were scored by the flying wing.

Harold served with the Royal Air Force throughout the second World War and played some exciting top class rugby in between doing his bit to thwart Adolf Hitler's match winning ambitions. During those years he played his rugby with some of the greats of those days and was numbered amongst the talented few.

When the War ended, Harold threw in his lost with Briton Ferry, Initially it was meant to be as a coach but he was soon back as a player and keep on playing he did until he was 40 years of age.

In 1953 Harold Powell became part of the administration at Neath. Some say, that he is now part of the furniture. Wherever you go with the All Blacks or in rugby circles someone is sure to know Harold.

Over the years he has been treasurer of the Social Club, a committee man and chairman of Neath Rugby Football Club on two occasions. Now he sits on the committee, and attends more regularly than most, as a Trustee.


For Harold Powell so far it has been a lifetime in rugby. Long may it continue. Happy Birthday, Harold!
