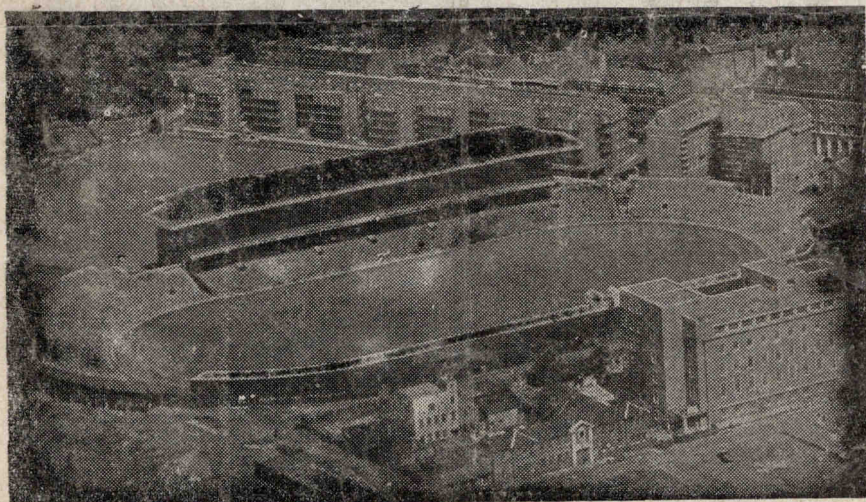

## CARDIFF v. LONDON WELSH

It is obvious that strong ties bind London Welsh to all other Welsh clubs but we of the Cardiff Club like to think that there is a particularly close bond between ourselves and our visitors to the Arms Park this afternoon.

The Exiles have brought a particularly strong XV to represent them which contains several Welsh Internationals and many who have played in Welsh trials. Their full-back, Alan Prosser-Harris is a tower of strength and a very accurate place-kicker.

Their back division is strong and speedy and the experimental law limiting the power of the wing forwards by keeping them down in the scrum until the ball is out which is being tried today, should suit the outside half, Paul Donovan, the ex-Penarth player who is a particularly elusive runner. The London Welsh strength does not only lie in their backs for they have brought with them a very fine pack containing as it does such well-known names as Derek Main, Leighton Jenkins, the former Newport player, and Gareth Payne, the ex-Pontypridd forward.

The Cardiff XV is much the same as that which defeated Gloucester last Wednesday but is strengthened by the return of Danny Harris and Cyril Davies.

It would appear that the Blue and Blacks have been conserving their energies until the latter part of each game this season for it is only then that they have gained the upper hand over their opponents and scored their points. Today, if they are to win against such formidable opponents they must start a little earlier in the game. Meirion Roberts is in very good form this season and is the key man in the Cardiff attack.

Next Wednesday on the ground the Athletic XV under the captaincy of ex-international Harry Morgan, play the first home fixture of the season against Old Penarthians. The Rags have won all their matches to date and once again have a very strong side with a fine blend of youth and experience.

The Athletic side on duty today—v. the Old Iltydians contains a half-back pair who will undoubtedly make their name in Welsh Rugger, Leo Karseras and the young and promising ex-Secondary Schools International, Brian Davies, who recently joined the club from Llanelly.

The Chairman of the Cardiff R.F.C. this season is that well-known character D. S. (Danny) Davies. Danny is of course a member of the Welsh Rugby Union and was Secretary of the last Lion's team to tour S. Africa. Danny retired from the Civil Service on Monday last and will now have ample time to devote to the game he has served so well.

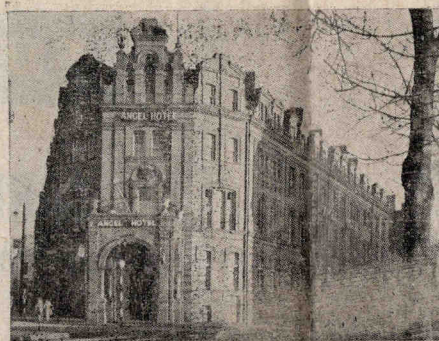
