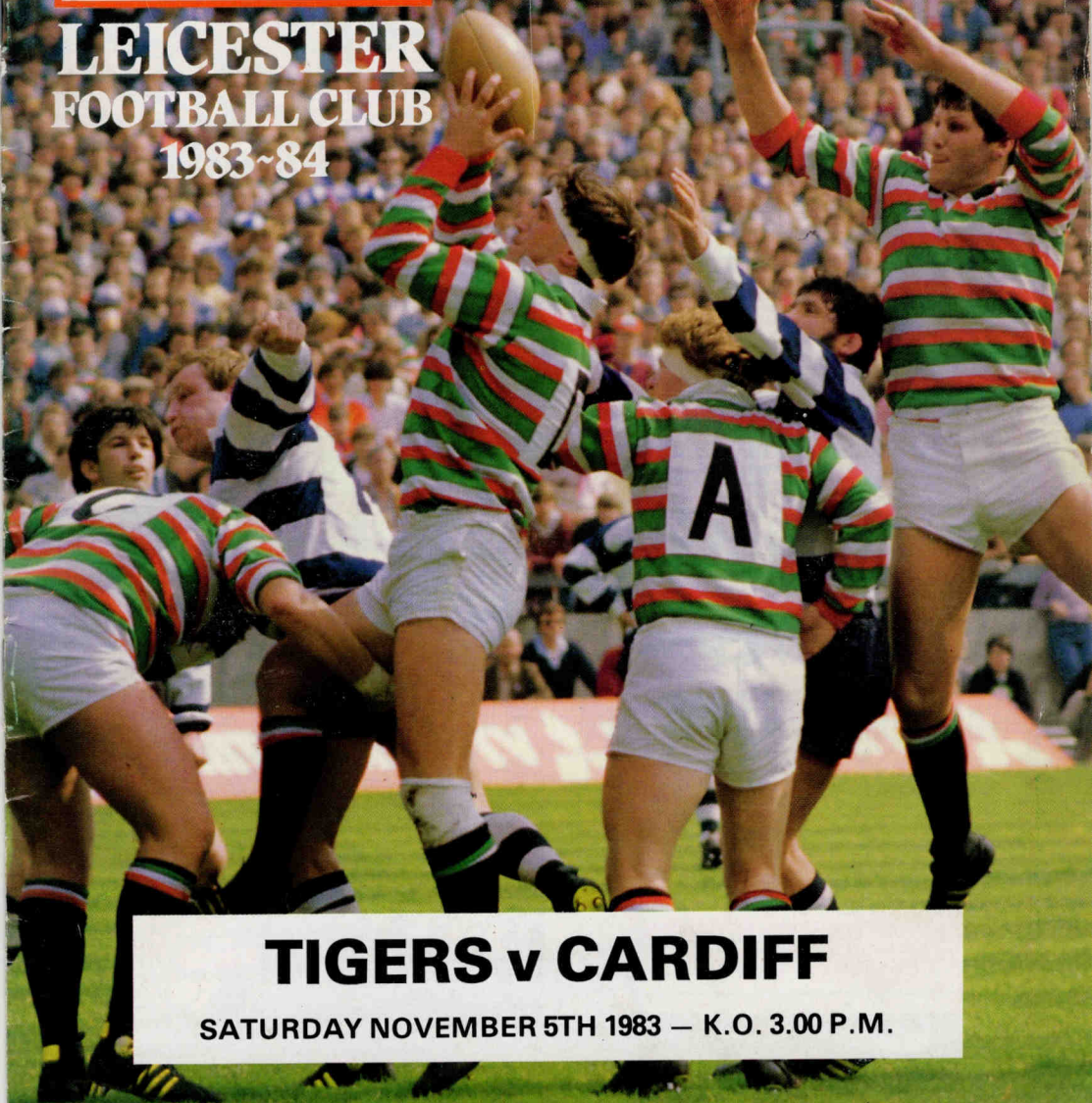



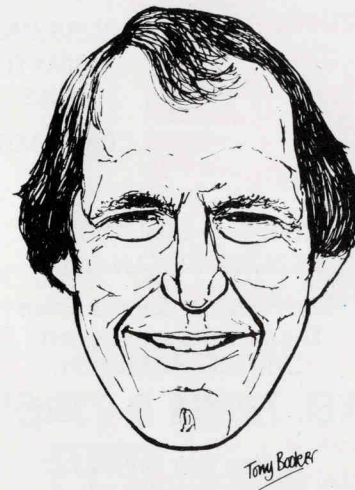


IT'S A TRY . . . Barry Evans goes over to open the scoring for Tigers.

Player Profile 'DUSTY' HARE



HARE, William Henry. 'Dusty', full-back. Born on 29th November, 1953 in Newark, and educated at Newark Magnus Grammar School, where, in fact, he started his playing career. Dusty joined Newark R.F.C. in 1970 before moving to Nottingham in 1971, remaining with them until 1976 when Leicester were fortunate enough to secure his talents.

As a 17 year old, Dusty played for the Midlands v Fiji side in 1970/71, and frequently turned out for Notts, Lincs and Derbys. In 1973 he was part of the England U23 squad which travelled to Japan, Tonga and Italy. Other tours to his credit include his selection for the England side to Japan, Argentina, Canada and U.S.A., the Five Nations side to open Ellis Park, South Africa, as well as participating in a Goal-Kicking Competition in Durban, South Africa. His most enjoyable tour was with the Tigers to Australia to celebrate the Club's Centenary. He has also played for the Midlands and Midlands & North, and has been invited to play for the Barbarians on a number of occasions. His first full International cap was in 1974 when he was part of the victorious England v Wales side. To date, Dusty has gained 18 caps for England — only one cap away from Bob Hillier's full back record. Included amongst these 18 appearances for England is his selection, along with team mates Paul Dodge, Peter Wheeler and Clive Woodward, for the Grand Slam side in 1980, when he will be long remembered for his kicking of that last minute penalty goal against Wales to clinch the game for England.

Dusty has made 206 appearances for Leicester, scoring 2,329 points to include 53 tries. He holds the Club record for the highest number of points scored in a season, 396, as well as the world record for the highest number of points scored, a fantastic total, so far, of 4,846.

Dusty stands 5'11" tall and weighs 12st 10lbs and is a farmer, married to Lesley with two children, Donna 6 years and Christopher 4 years. During the summer months, when his farming activities permit, he sheds his sheep farming wellies and turns out for a local cricket side, previously having played County Cricket for Nottinghamshire.

Leicester and Cardiff are the only clubs to have scored over 400pts this season with the Tigers just in front with 460pts. Cardiff's two defeats this season were in the opening game of the season 9-3pts to Abertillery and 32-21pts at Rodney Parade against Newport. Since that surprise defeat against their local rivals, Cardiff have had six successive games without defeat, which included a 10-9pts midweek win at Pontypool. It was the first time Pontypool Park had witnessed a home defeat in 36 matches stretching back to April 1982. And just to prove that they are in cracking form they walloped Moseley last Saturday 43-10pts.

A number of the Cardiff players will also be waiting for the Welsh squad to be announced to play Romania in Bucharest next Saturday, especially winger Adrian Hadley and the props J. Whitefoot and I. Eidman, who played against Japan. Whatever, the sides, today will produce the top British team, and if a new record is set, it will not be won easily.

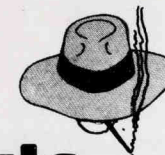

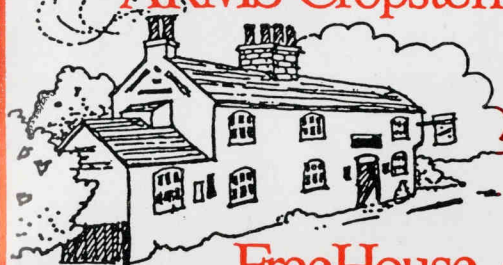
