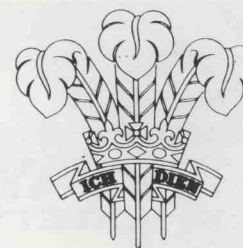

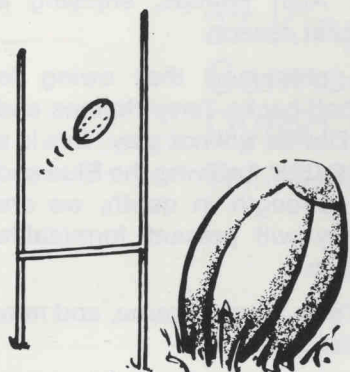

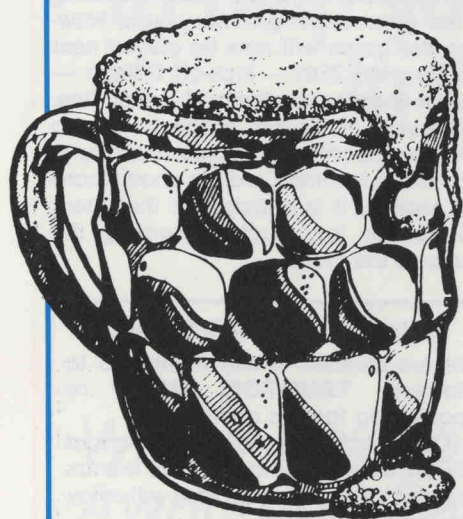

A presentation was made at Tumble RFC clubhouse to a young Newcastle Emlyn man — Mark Hesford — who is paralysed and confined to a wheelchair following a serious road accident.

The village folk of Tumble made this gesture as a mark of gratitude to the people of Newcastle Emlyn, who themselves rallied around in force to donate to a similar fund in Tumble some six years ago, when one of the Gwendraeth Valley's young players — Malcolm Stephens — was seriously injured and paralysed whilst playing in a rugby match.

The Tumble RFC committee launched the fund with a concert, and this was followed by other activities, including a sponsored walk from Tumble to Newcastle Emlyn, a distance of 33 miles. One of the 23 walkers who took part — Huw Williams — walked the whole distance carrying a sack of potatoes weighing 60lbs on his back. The walk itself raised over £700 bringing the total to the fund from Tumble RFC to £1000, and this cheque was presented to Mark by the Chairman of the Rugby Club, Mr. Ieuan Williams.

LAST CARDIFF VISIT

26th November, 1983 — Llanelli 14pts - Cardiff 13pts

Scrum-half Mark Douglas produced one of his finest games for the Scarlets and showed he is equipped to play for Wales if Terry Holmes is absent.

Against Cardiff, Douglas enjoyed a flow of possession, especially from the line-out where, Phil May at the front, Rhys Thomas in the middle, and Alun Davies at the back, operated at peak efficiency. Phil May claimed it was the forwards' best performance of the season.

Cardiff, defeated in only three of the previous nineteen games, anticipated a more constant source of supply. The stubborn resistance of the home pack enclosed the Cardiff back row, prohibiting close order operation, and they were unable to break out and exert their authority. Consequently there were only occasional moments when Owen Golding and Bob Lakin directed their

flair. David Pickering caught the eye with his determination with Buchanan, Townley, Delaney and Nick Sanders working unsparingly.

Cardiff's outstanding player was Paul Rees, strong and aggressive, always up with the attackers and popped up twice in one exciting move. Both outside-halves accomplished their task with precision. Gary Pearce established a platform for his forwards, as did Gareth Davies for Cardiff.

Particularly noteworthy was Mark Ring's tackling of powerful Ray Gravell, who applied the same measures when the roles were reversed. 'Grav', making his 450th appearance for the Scarlets, relished the duel, and his side finished three tries to Cardiff's one. Gareth Davies supplied three penalties and Alan Phillips a try. Llanelli's tries were scored by Phil Lewis (2) and Peter Morgan, Martin Gravelle converting one.
