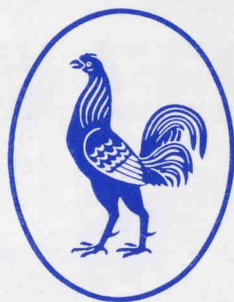

Player Profile

A brand new season and a brand new coach. Congratulations and best wishes to Mike Rafter.

He tells us that's his full name and he was born in Bristol on 31st March 1952. His height is 5ft 10ins, and his weight is 14 stone 3lbs. Mike joined Bristol straight after playing for St. Brendan's College and had a spell away at St. Luke's College, Exeter. Mike has had many honours, among them 17 full England caps and has toured Fiji, Tonga and Japan in 1979, and Argentina in 1981. for his county (Gloucestershire) his appearances included 7 years as captain from 1978 - 1985. In 1983 and in 1984 he led them to the County Championship. For Bristol he has made over 250 appearances but admits to scoring "not very many" points. He was of course Club Captain for the seasons 1982-83 and 1983-84. On each occasion Bristol appeared in the John Player Cup Final at Twickenham and so Mike's best rugby moments, needless to say, was in taking part in the winning performance in 1983 and his worst rugby moment was taking part in the defeat in 1984. He also has many other favourite rugby moments including the two County Championship successes and playing in Celebration matches such as England and Wales v. Scotland and Ireland at Cardiff in 1980 and in 1983 playing for the Rest of the World against Wales also at Cardiff. Mike also mentioned other "least favourite" rugby moments such as being dropped by England on several occasions and also being dropped by Bristol for the St. Ives match!

Mike's favourite players include Gareth Edwards and Jean-Pierre Reves and, from England, Paul Dodge. His most difficult opponent has been Phil Bennett. Mike is a family man, having married Anna Van Wely and his daughter Lauren is 3 years old. He works as a Fleet Sales Executive at Bryan Bros. His favourite musician is Gerry Rafferty, Favourite comedian is the late Tommy Cooper and he enjoys natural history programmes such as World About Us on TV, also Cheers! His favourite food is Chicken Tikka Moussalade (? Indian spelling!). We asked him the person he'd most like to meet to which his reply was "I'd like to have a chat with Maggie Thatcher!"

Mike's rugby ambition is to coach Bristol to the John Player Championship. His final comment was that as coach he'd like to aim for success "but not at all costs. I think pleasure in playing is all-important and pleasure for the spectators. That's the name of the game and if you get enjoyment you get success"
