#### **Club Notes**

Welcome to a new season of Rugby Football at the Memorial Ground. There can be no better way to start our programme than entertaining Cardiff. Our visitors are our oldest opponents and are justifable famous for their play and players. In the near future Cardiff will entertain the 'All Blacks' so today's game is of considerable importance in their team preparation. Our own team has been in training since early July so today's encounter will be between two well prepared teams.

During the close season our players have been actively engaged. Once again our Seven-A-Side Squad acquitted themselves with distinction in the Middlesex tournament losing in extra time in the semi-finals. The President of Middlesex wrote to the Club to say how much pleasure our teams had given the crowds over the last two years. Our senior squad visited America in May and played five games and won them all inspite of high temperatures and excessive humidity.

Next Wednesday Bristol "A" will play their first game of the season when they visit North Bristol. Dennis Skinner has put together an excellent card for the "A" XV considering he had so little time. It is interesting to note that the present United XV (Second XV) were called Bristol "A" when they played their first fixtures in early 1890's and by 1892 the Bristol Club were fielding three teams. The Annual Report of 1900—1901 gave details of the Committee's reasons for discontinuing the Third XV. The Club continued to field two teams until the outbreak of the First World War. Immediately after the War the Club fielded only one team and it was not until September 16th 1922 that the Second XV recommenced fixtures. Since then the Club has regularly fielded two senior fifteens. The addition of the Colts to the organization of the Club has been a blessing in many ways. It has enabled many youngsters to receive high quality coaching and excellent matches which has in turn, benefited the Bristol Club and many other Clubs. The reformation of the Bristol "A" XV (Third XV) is a continuation of this programme of education and development. The Club has invested a great deal of time. finance and playing expertize in this project and it deserves to succeed.

The common thread that has run through the Bristol Club's existance has been its fixtures with the Cardiff Club. Irrespective of Leagues, Cups, Representative matches, inclement weather, waterlogged and frozen pitches the Clubs have met, enjoyed their matches and have enriched the lifes of players and watchers alike. Long may it continue.
