



### **CLUB NOTES**

Newport and CARDIFF have battled for supremacy for over three hundred and sixty times since the clubs started fixtures in 1876. Up to 1976 the "friendly enemies" played each other four times a season, such was the aura that seemed to attach itself to the fixture. Regardless of the form of one side or the other, the occasion always seemed to bring out the proud traditions of both clubs. In the late Forties and early Fifties the Newport club had crowds of over 20,000 on seven occasions — little wonder Cardiff provided the opposition no fewer than five times. At the Arms Park in February 1951 some 48,500 were present — a world record for an inter-club game.

Cardiff enjoyed a golden era from 1890 until 1910 when such players as Tommy Pearson, Gwyn Nicholls, Rhys Gabe and Percy Bush became household names. The inter-War years continued to produce outstanding players — Tom Wallace, Danny Davies, Arthur Cornish, Ronnie Boon, Harry Bowcott, Codger Johnson, Les Spence, Cliff Jones and Wilf Wooler to name but a few.

In the three seasons leading up to the 2nd World War the Cardiff club won three consecutive championships and resumed after hostilities in similar style by taking that honour again in 1948 and 1949. In 1948 the Cardiff club provided ten players for

the Welsh XV to play Scotland.

The second golden era lasted until 1958, during which time the club beat the All Blacks in 1953, and international players such as Cliff Morgan, Rex Willis, Jack Matthews, Bleddyn Williams and Billy Cleaver became British Lions. Cardiff continued to be a magnet for players from all over the country and such greats as Barry John, Gareth Edwards, Maurice Richards, John Scott (England), Gerald Davies, Gareth Davies, Terry Holmes and Bob Norster have all worn the Blue and Black jersey.

For the past few seasons the Cardiff club has suffered a few hiccups, but with a side bristling with talent and a place in the Premier Division, Cardiff will still be "the

team everyone wants to beat".







### Great Names of the Past...

#### ... Cardiff's BLEDDYN WILLIAMS

Recognized as the greatest post-war centre by many critics, Bleddyn Williams was born in Taffs Well into a large family of boys, all of whom played with distinction for the Cardiff Club. Two of them, Gwyn and Cenydd, were to turn professional, Lloyd and Bleddyn won international caps, and Tony and Elwyn played over 300 games for the Blue and Blacks.

When he was a pupil at Rydal School, Bleddyn was to star as an outside-half, but during his service in the R.A.F., where he played a great deal of rugby with seasoned Rugby Union and Rugby League stars, he reverted to centre. On his demob he formed, with Jack Matthews and Billy Cleaver, probably the most formidable midfield trio in Cardiff's history. When Cardiff won the Welsh Club Championship in 1947/8, winning 39 games out of 41, Williams scored 41 tries.

Bleddyn was 5'10" and 13 stones and he was a brilliant attacking player with a devastating side-step. He was able to outwit covering defences with his jinking runs carried out at speed, and he had an ability to give beautifully-timed passes to his colleagues. Tragically he was to suffer several injuries which restricted the number of games he played for his country. In actual fact he played in only 22 games out of a possible 39 during his career which ended in May 1955.

Bleddyn Williams went on the Lions tour to Australasia in 1950 as vice-captain and he scored 13 tries in 20 games, although he missed the early part of the tour through injury. He did, however, captain the side in two tests in New Zealand and one in Australia. In 1953 he led Cardiff to an epic victory over the All Blacks by 8pts to 3pts and a few weeks later repeated the performance when Wales came back from the dead to win by 13pts to 8pts.

#### ... Newport's MALCOLM THOMAS


Malcolm Thomas learned his rugby at Bassaleg School, Newport, where he also excelled on the cricket field. He played for Wales in both games before entering Caerleon Training College. While still a student he played for the Newport club and quickly gained international recognition. Malcolm was first capped against France in 1949 and in a remarkable international career he played twenty-one times at centre, five times as a wing, and in his last game in Paris, in 1959, he was the Welsh outside-half.

Malcolm Thomas was the "baby" on the 1950 Lions tour. Nine years later he made his second trip to the Antipodes. In 1950 Thomas was top scorer with 96pts. He scored 73pts in twelve games in New Zealand where in the opening game at Nelson he scored 21pts, including six penalties. On the second tour with the Lions M.C. Thomas was the invaluable utility player and he played in every positioin behind the scrum except inside-half.

Malcolm Thomas was 5'10" and stockily built at 13½ stones. He had a powerful hand-off and he was a determined tackler. Although he was often denied opportunities by better kickers, he was an excellent exponent of the punt and penalty. Malcolm Thomas was a "one-club man" and Newport was his first and only love. He did, however, become an instructor-lieutenant in the Royal Navy where he captained Devonport Services and the full Navy XV which won the Inter-Services Championship in 1951. On his return to Wales, Thomas captained Newport: from 1954 to 1957. He was dogged by injury during his career and before he could assume the captaincy for the first time he broke a leg in the club trial! In 1955/6 under his leadership Newport won the Welsh Championship, the Sevens, and Monmouthshire the Welsh Counties Championship. There is probably no parallel in rugby history with the career of Malcolm Thomas.




