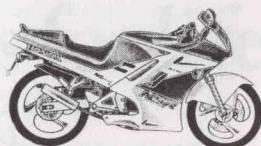

So here we go into the second half of the season and as far as the Wizards are concerned let's hope the inward eleven matches prove more successful than the outward eleven. The most positive aspect of our 28-7 defeat against Pontypridd at Sardis Road was that the rot was stopped at half time. Having trailed by 28 points at the break, the Wizards 'won' the second half through a try from Simon Hutchinson — his second for the club — goaled by Ioan Bebb. All league matches are important to Aberavon at the moment, but the real crunch games will come in December when Dunvant visit the Talbot Athletic Ground (December 4th) and when we head for Cross Keys the following week. Those were the only two clubs that Aberavon defeated in the outward programme and if you ask coaches Clive Rowlands and Ian Bremner what they would like for Christmas, you can be sure they will answer you with: "Four points from our two pre-Christmas league games!" Former Ynysybwl and Pontypool hooker, Andrew Pickering, made his debut for Aberavon, along with scrum half Martin Rees (Hendy), lock Jason Lewis (Resolven) and flanker David Morgan (BSC Port Talbot) in our impressive 25-6 home win over the Zebras. A scintillating second half break from skipper John Jardine, set the Wizards up for the kill, and the Zebras went home with tails between legs. Congratulations to Phil Middleton on reaching 100 appearances for the club when he came on as a 55th minute replacement for Phil Hamley at Pontypridd. Ton up Wizards are becoming a rarity these days with Phil — happily restored from a serious knee injury sustained against Aberavon Quins in September — joining a select band of only eight. The 100 club men include hooker Anthony Jones, who it appears has departed from the club after making 110 appearances. Leading the way is senior statesman Jeff Jenkins on 189. Jeff made his club debut at Glais on September 14th, 1981 and after a nomadic journey around Welsh clubs — taking in stays at Cardiff and Bridgend — reappeared in our 17-10 win at Maesteg on October 5th; Captain John Jardine, who made his club debut in Valencia on May 2nd, 1986, has appeared 171 times with Richard Diplock (debut: Neath, April 23rd, 1984) due to clock up 150 if he plays against Cardiff today. Back row forward, Phil Hamley, is on 126 (club debut at Pontypridd, October 19th, 1988); Lyndon Lewis 115 (debut: Central Glamorgan, September 2nd, 1986) and last but not least, Neil Forrester 113 (debut: Cardiff, September 24th, 1988). Leading club try scorer is Richard Diplock on 50, followed by John Jardine (36), Dean Griffiths (25), Phil Middleton (23), Lyndon Lewis (18), and Neil Forrester (14). Forrester leads on points with 481, then comes Lewis (228), Diplock (207), Jardine (151), Griffiths (108) and Middleton (100).

By their high standards, Cardiff will have been disappointed to lose to the other members of the 'super league' at the top of the Heineken League Division One. They will have to reverse defeats against Llanelli (15-9), Neath (11-6) and Swansea (22-6) in the second half of the season to have any hope of the championship. Even in these days when we feel the 'top four' clubs are almost infallible, only two years ago Cardiff struggled and would have been playing in Division Two last year but for restructuring. And with the possibility of an Anglo-Welsh League being born next season, Cardiff will be keen to finish as high as possible in the league should they eventually drop out of contention for the title. Cardiff possess a good record against Aberavon and have won 57 out of the 89 post-war meetings between the clubs, with the Wizards trailing on 27. Aberavon last beat Cardiff at the Arms Park on September 26th, 1987, 15-12, while at the Talbot Athletic Ground you have to go back a further year to find a scoreline of Aberavon 26, Cardiff 22.

CHAIRMAN'S ADDRESS

Chairman of Aberavon R.F.C., Haldon Lodwig, writes . . .

On behalf of the Aberavon Rugby Football Club, I would like to extend a warm welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Cardiff R.F.C.

It was with eager anticipation that we started this season's Heineken League programme back in early September with our first away match at Cardiff.

At that time, in brilliant sunshine, we were somewhat lucky to come second, having felt the full force of Cardiff's attacking prowess.

As everyone is now aware, we have reached the Heineken League halfway stage, with our home fixture against Cardiff today being the reversed venues from September.

Our league points to date is only standing at a disappointing five points, with Pontypool's home win against fellow strugglers Cross Keys last week ensuring that they have four points. It is essential to all concerned at Aberavon that we start winning league games. I thought that our second half performance at Pontypridd last Saturday was encouraging — it was good to see key players who have returned from injury come through with little ill effects. One essential fact that I have found this season, and despite our league losses, is the tremendous spirit that exists with players and coaches.

The standard of league rugby is however extremely disappointing to say the least — the pressure of league points is undoubtedly having an adverse affect on rugby playing standards.

Today's game clashes with the live televising of the England v. New Zealand match. It is with disappointment that I have to report that every effort was made to switch the game to either Friday night or Sunday afternoon — in these circumstances it is essential that both clubs agree to change, and unfortunately Cardiff R.F.C. would not accept Aberavon's proposal.

It is worth noting that today's match celebrates 100 years of matches between the two clubs. The first official match was held on March 11th, 1893, although prior to this, games against Cardiff 'A' had been played.
