**CHAIRMAN'S REPORT**  
**END OF SEASON REPORT 2018 / 19**

**Cardiff Blues**

Cardiff Blues had a mixed season on the playing front, which was defined by the first and last three games of the season.

Ultimately, the Blues narrowly missed out on not only the Guinness PRO14 play-offs but also a place in the top tier European Champions Cup. Losing those first three games, all by one score and in the last minutes, was particularly damaging, however they still had a chance of qualifying going into the final weeks of the season. Defeats to the Ospreys and Connacht, where an incorrect refereeing decision was made, proved particularly costly.

Despite this there were plenty of positives that can be built upon, with a new coaching group and an attractive, free-flowing style of rugby really developing. Seven of the games lost were by a score or less, which demonstrates the very fine margins.

Alun Jones became the new Chairman, replacing Peter Thomas, who has generously relinquished a large portion of his loans off the Blues balance sheet. Martyn Ryan & Paul Bailey have also done the same and we wish Paul all our very best in his recuperation.

Sir Gareth Edwards has resigned from his position on the board, which has been followed by Paul Bailey's decision to leave.

A special mention must be made of Mr John Smart, who passed away during the season. He was one of the original board members of Cardiff RFC & Cardiff Blues, his financial contribution and devotion to Cardiff Rugby should never be forgotten.

With the exception of Gareth Anscombe and Rhys Carré, the Blues managed to retain some 20 players and have strengthened the squad with the acquisition of Hallam Amos, Josh Adams, Will Boyde and Jason Tovey.

Season Memberships and match-day attendances were up season-on-season and 2019-20 memberships are once again tracking ahead of target.

**Cardiff RFC**

Cardiff RFC enjoyed one of its best seasons in a long while, winning the Welsh Cup beating Merthyr 25-19, despite being 12-0 down in the early stages. Tries by Tom Daley, Edd Howley & Ben Thomas with two conversions and two penalty kicks by the ever reliable Gareth Thompson sealed the victory. The final twist of the game with Merthyr pushing for the win resulted in Ed Howley catching a deep penalty kick to the corner and punching the ball close to the opponent's ten metre line, sinking fifteen Merthyr hearts.

Also Cardiff RFC finished runners up in the Principality Premiership league to Merthyr, winning 22 of 30 games losing 7 and 1 draw. CRFC were in the hunt all

season but possibly with the Cup and league demands it proved a bridge too far to claim the double. There were so many notable victories, such as the Aberavon win at Talbot Athletic Ground, the televised game at The Wern to defeat Merthyr, or my personal favourite, the demolition of Ebbw Vale at Cardiff Arms Park, especially the first 40 minutes.

Positive BBC coverage of the Premiership games throughout the season certainly raised the profile of the League. It is anticipated that this will remain for next season. The obvious question will then be, what is the purpose of the league and how can it improve? Unfortunately with the advent of Regional A sides, this potentially dilutes our team. Rest assured our duty to Cardiff RFC is always at the forefront and we will endeavour to raise such standards that an A side is not necessary in today's game.

I would like to think this is just the beginning of something special. We are ambitious and we want to build a strong, sustainable club as we move towards our 150th anniversary in 2026.

We are working more closely than ever with the Blues and I think we are finally developing a better relationship built on mutual understanding, joint benefit and respect. As an example two full time ex under 20 Internationals, namely James Rati & Callum Bradbury will be at our disposal.

As reported last year, Steve Law had secured a Cardiff squad independently from the Blues, which challenged all teams this season, next season will see a similar approach by the Blue & Blacks. Steve has met the Blues regularly when securing next year's squad and the quality available is very encouraging, namely Brynley Toms, Ollie Drake, Evan Yardley, Nathan Hudd, Alex Everett, James Thomas, Tom Habberfield, Ben Williams, Leon Andrews, Joseph Scrivens, Barney Nightingale & Sam Beard have all signed recently.

The premiership in season 2019/20 will be fought out by twelve teams, with only one team being relegated. Even though there is a reduction of fixtures, there will be a cross border competition with Scotland's Super Six held at the end of the season to compensate.

The Caps Presentation & Hall Of Fame Dinner held at The Exchange hotel formerly known as The Coal Exchange was the highlight off the field, with many awards being given by Cardiff Former Players to this seasons recipients. The night was superbly hosted by Cardiff RFC Fan & Award winning Journalist Carolyn Hitt. Terry Holmes was our Guest of Honour, who welcomed inductee Steve Ford to the Hall Of Fame.
