Cardiff RFC- Chairman's end of season report 2017/18

Whilst writing the chairman's report, it was announced by Cardiff Blues that Peter Thomas was stepping down as chairman of the region in forthcoming year. He will handover the reigns to a new chairman in readiness for season 2019/20. Peter will remain as a major shareholder of the board and also take his position of Life President.

Peter's contribution to Cardiff Rugby has been colossal, without his financial backing there would be a strong possibility that professional rugby in Cardiff would not exist.

We owe him a great debt of gratitude for his services to Cardiff and wish him well in the future. With a clear involvement from WRU, they have recognised the need to support the Region not only with extra finance but clear guidelines on the governance of the board. There will be an appointment of three non executive directors and continued dialogue on how the Blues can expand on its position of being based in the capital city.

Cardiff Blues season ended successfully, reaching the position of fourth in Conference A, which gains them a Champions Cup entry next season.

Obviously the winning of the European Challenge Cup against Gloucester in Bilbao was a tremendous victory, coming back from a half time deficit of 20-6. The sheer determination of the players in the second half was legendary, with Ellis Jenkins and Gareth Anscombe inspirational.

The sad loss of coaches Danny Wilson & Matt Sherratt to Scotland & Ospreys respectively, we certainly wish them well in their new positions.

Congratulations and welcome to new head coach John Mulvihill on signing a three year deal, building on Danny Wilson's legacy.

Also good luck to new staff members Jason Strange and Tom Smith, together with Duane Goodfield and Richard Hodges on the completion of 1st team coaching group.

Cardiff RFC season ended disappointedly, with a final position of 8th in the 16 team premiership league. However there were strong periods where the team were in the top three but the injury count was surreal, with many first team players unavailable in the last three months of the competition, notably the loss of our captain Joe Tomlinson, so early in the season. However the 5 game winning run was the highlight especially the victory at Carmarthen Quins 34-10

With the advent of A team/under 23 rugby next year, we have the benefit of head coach Steve Law having more players at his disposal. It has been recognised that there will only be ten fixtures or so, leaving many players without rugby during the season.

Not withstanding that, Steve has secured a Cardiff squad independently from the Blues, which he believes can seriously challenge any team next year. It must be recognised how important next season is, as the league is being whittled down to 12 teams the year after. The idea of Cardiff RFC not being in the top flight is unthinkable. Steve has met the Blues regularly when securing next years squad and the quality available is very encouraging, namely Martin Roberts, Morgan Allen, Steff Jones, Zac O' Driscoll, Kieron Martin. Joe Gatt, Mathew Powell & Morgan Griffiths have all signed recently.

The premiership in season 2018/19 will remain (at present), East/West divisions of 8 teams, will secure 29 games including a host of local derby's, with the added excitement of the importance of every game, as 4 teams will be relegated and the bottom fifth team will have a play off with the winners of the Championship.

Congratulations on the following players receiving their caps, namely Llywarch Ap Myrddin, Ian Jenkins, Will Rees Hole, Ben White, Frazer Young, Peter Lloyd & Rhodri Cole.

Gareth Thompson was top point's scorer with 242 points a gain of forty from his last years total. Will Rees Hole was top try scorer with 15 tries.

The player with most appearances was Luke Crocker (Flanker), who played in 29 games, who also gained the player of the year Award. The most promising player of the year was awarded to Peter Lloyd (Prop), whilst playing under permit from Glamorgan Wanderers; he played like a seasoned pro in this year's premiership.

Many thanks to our head coach, Steve Law and his coaching team, Llyr Lane, Neil Edwards, James Dixon and Our Team manager, Iestyn Williams, for their efforts in what has been a promising year.

Dyfri Owen and his team of physiotherapists make a continued contribution to the well being of the players on & off the pitch. Our thanks also to our dedicated team of doctors.

Many thanks to Abbie Gibbins for her ability to assist CRFC in all matters especially the 141st club dinner.

Also to Jamie Muir, Ian Richards and Rhiannon Loxton for their contribution on pre-planning & match days when the new security measures have proved to be challenging.

Our Licensee Karl Kruger Williams & his bar staff have always shown support, whether training nights or match days, or even nights where Karl energises the members bar with a song or two.

May I also thank Mike Salt and Spiro and his team for their attention to the needs of the players and the post match snacks for the Trophy Room.

Head grounds man Matt Jones continues to maintain our well utilised artificial playing surface to a high standard, but also his unwavering support during our games either home or away.

May I thank committee members for their contributions this past season. Chris Collins for attending every Blues South 16's & 18's fixtures ensuring that Cardiff RFC was represented.

Brian Bennett, Marc Wakeham for attending East District meetings and John Huw Williams for attending Cardiff & District Meetings.

Clive Davies for his work on the 141st Dinner and premiership meetings. Jill Parker a passionate secretary who works tirelessly for the RFC.

Ian Tabor & daughter Ellie for match day PA, our website and production of our match day programme. David Morgan for his organisation of our ball boys & girls at each home game Dave Perkins, Hugh Campbell & Christine Buss selling our programmes on match day.

Gareth Nicholas. who has worked tremendously with Blues South 18's, supplying a watch list of 14 players for the future but also working with the Elite 16 year olds with high quality conditioning at Cardiff Met and skills sessions. Simon Down our vice chairman & Blues Director has been a much needed colleague when we have had challenging times.

Congratulations to Mervyn John who had stepped down from committee but received an award to be a member of the Cardiff RFC 'Hall of Fame'. He remains a trustee of CAC.

Our ever present Photographer, Viv Jones has also joined our heritage group who were responsible for the creation of the CRFC museum. Also big thanks to members of the CF10 group whose work on this project was much needed.

A special mention to Billy Woods & Brian Bennett on their resignation from the CRFC committee, two people who's support has been greatly appreciated. Billy will now enjoy his time with us as Vice President and Brian who remains a CAC Trustee.

Peter Thomas, Martyn Ryan, Richard Holland, Paul Bailey together with the remaining directors of the limited company continue to support the RFC.
